**St. John Bosco** was born in Turin, Italy, in 1815. He lost his father at a very early age and was devoutly brought up by a loving mother who taught him the ways of life.

John Bosco, popularly known as Don Bosco was ordained a priest at the age of twenty six. He immediately began his work with homeless youth by opening a home for them where his mother served as a house-keeper. Within a short time, a hundred and fifty deprived youngsters were given food and shelter. They were instructed in religion and given opportunities to learn trade skills. Workshops for tailoring, shoemaking and printing were set up, and Don Bosco trained his staff to assist him in caring for the boys.

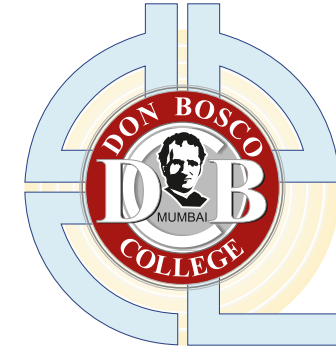
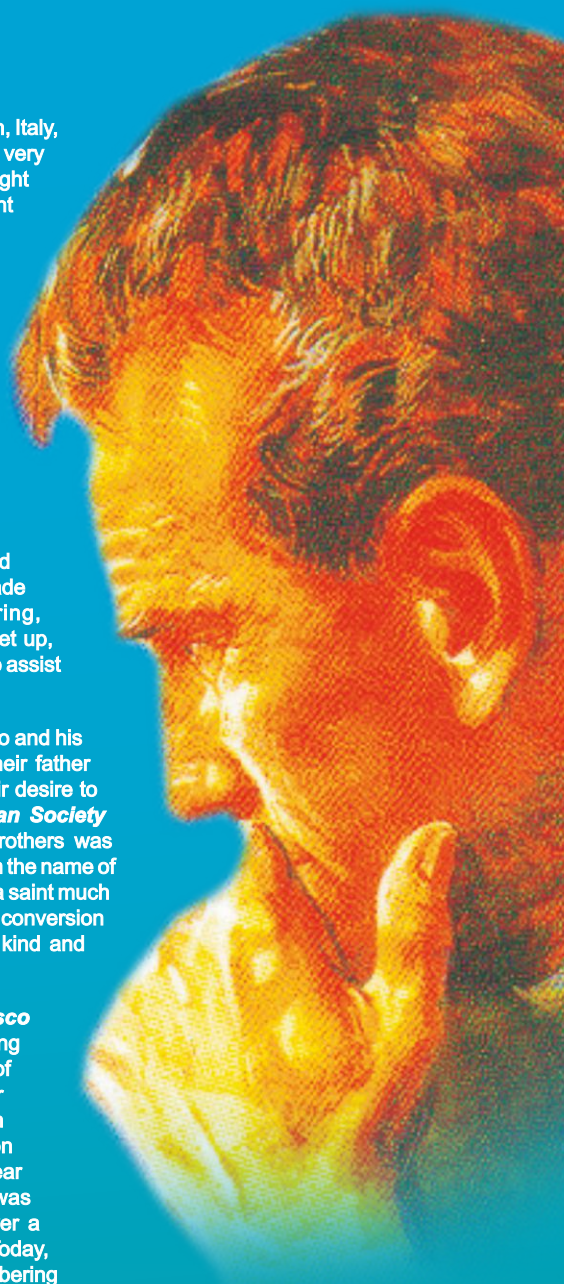
Those associated with Don Bosco and his work began to accept him as their father and guide. Some expressed their desire to be like him. And so the **Salesian Society** comprising of priests and lay-brothers was born. (The word '**Salesian**' is from the name of the patron, St. Francis de Sales, a saint much admired by Don Bosco for his conversion from an angry young man to a kind and gentle bishop).

The **Salesians of Don Bosco** dedicate themselves to providing education, trade skills and care of deprived youngsters. Their mission spread rapidly through the entire country. When Don Bosco left this world in the year 1888, a congregation that was twenty years in service, had over a thousand dedicated members. Today, the Salesians of Don Bosco, numbering around 20,000, are scattered in more than 128 countries across the globe.

The greatest gift Don Bosco bestowed is, his unique way to educate. A motivating way to teach that could only come with inspirational & spiritual obsession. "It is enough to know that you are young and abandoned, for me to love you very much".

More than a century after the death of Don Bosco, thousands of people have dedicated themselves to continue his apostolic love for young people. **Salesians of Don Bosco** (sdb) as they are called, having a single mission the world over, - "to be signs and bearers of God's love for the young".
